This has been another busy year for the BFAA.

Negotiations were completed for moving the annual juried show from the small Perry Gallery to the large Lee Chin Gallery. The show will involve all the Guilds and will take place in April 2015.

The AGB has accepted our proposal for the 50th Anniversary of BFAA. In 2016 we will host a forward looking show for two months in the large Lee Chin Gallery, with the theme "Burlington: Urban and Rural." Also, running simultaneously, we have booked the Fireside Lounge for a retrospective show, as requested by many members of the BFAA. Details of how to become involved in these shows will be presented over the next couple of months.

At this year's Kaleidoscope show we instituted a large portrait and still life demo with live models, which was well received by all the other guilds as well as the public.

A Plein Air lunch was successfully held in April with people from our guild as well as members of the Monday Painters.

A new backsplash was installed in the Fine Arts Studio.

A new location for our guild to show its paintings began this year at Gelderman's Landscaping Offices north of Waterdown, and has been running well, thanks to Tamara Kwapich.

On top of all this, our regular activities have continued, such as the Wednesday morning Sketch Group (which concentrates on life drawing, still life, and portraits), the Plein Air Painting Group who paint outdoors every Thursday morning from May to November, the Fireside Lounge shows, Hall of Art shows, Art Appreciation presentations, workshops on acrylic painting and printmaking as well as our monthly General Meeting presentations, our twice annual Pot Luck Dinners, and our monthly newsletter. Art Appreciation continues to be a popular program mainly due to the efforts of Doug Cockell. Also June Watson will again become involved in future presentations.

That's a lot of stuff going on for a small group of people.

The next year will be a window of opportunity to enhance the presence of the Guilds as the AGB hires a new director.

An organization like ours runs purely on the energy input from its members. As in any organization of its kind, some members put in more time than others for a variety of reasons. Of course, after some people have been doing a particular job for a while, it is natural for them to want to do something different, or maybe just to take a break. If we want to see a wide range of programs continue in the BFAA, we need some new volunteers to step up and fill in the vacancies and bring new ideas and fresh perspective to our organization. In particular we need someone to be Vice President, who will take over as President in 2016.



If you wish to have an opening in the Fireside Lounge, you must contact Angi Goobie to book the room. The fee is \$85.00

If you wish to exhibit, please send me a short Bio of your exhibits. You must have been accepted in at least TWO Juried Exhibitions. You must wait 3 years before exhibiting again in the Fireside Lounge. You must also have been a member of Fine Arts and AGB for at least one year.

When you exhibit in the Fireside you are required to sign a statement that you will pay 20% commission to the BFAA for anything that is sold while it is hanging there, and also for any painting sold afterwards within the month after the show is down, based on the purchaser having seen it at the Fireside Lounge. The BFAA keeps 10% and gives 10% to the Arts Burlington Council. It is up to the artists to be on their honour and pay the 20% commission to our Treasurer.
