President's Message

Can Art be Defined?

My purpose in writing these articles is to provide food for thought and discussion. I return again to a favourite topic, and one which I know many BFAA members are passionate about.

What defines art can become very controversial among the academic art community, sometimes leaving the rest of us scratching our heads. Why this appears to be is because most discussions about art concentrate on controversial pieces of art that exist on the fringes, what are called outliers. But there is art that exists naturally in human life. There are some intrinsic qualities which most of us return to when evaluating a piece of art. Denis Dutton expresses these ideas verv well in his book "The Art Instinct." I have included a partial list of what he includes in his list of art attributes, which easily move across cultural boundaries, and tend to be accepted globally without much help from academics and theorists.

- 1) Art gives direct pleasure through enjoyment of artistic beauty.
- 2) The making of the Art Object or Performance requires the exercise of great skill beyond what the average person in the community is capable of.
- 3) The art demonstrates novelty, creativity, and originality.
- Most humans look for art to represent something or an idea they can relate to. People delight in art that represents the life they see around them.

Installation: Work will be installed on the 4th and 5th of September.


Note:

If you wish to have an opening in the Fireside Lounge, you must contact Angi to book the room. I believe the fee is \$75.00

If you wish to exhibit, please send me a short Bio of your exhibits. You must have been accepted in at least TWO Juried Exhibitions. You must wait 3 years before exhibiting again in the Fireside Gallery. You must also have been a member of Fine Arts for at least one year as well as the BAC.

When you exhibit in the Fireside you are required to sign a statement that you will pay 20% commission to the BFAA for anything that is sold while it is hanging there, and also for any painting sold afterwards within the month after the show is down, based on the purchaser having seen it at the Fireside Gallery. The BFAA keeps 10% and gives 10% to the Arts Burlington Council. It is up to the artists to be on their honour and pay the 20% commission to our Treasurer.
