President's Message

Art Materials

All those wonderful colours of paint that capture our imaginations in the art stores we visit. Due to my years in scientific research, I continue to be interested in the technical aspects of paint ingredients, even though this information does nothing to improve my skills in painting.

The artistic market for pigments, the solid powders that give paint its colour, is very small. With few exceptions, the range and quality of pigments available to artists depends entirely on the colour requirements of large consumer products and manufacturing companies - manufacturers of foods, house paints, inks, automobiles and plastics in particular. The best chemical manufacturing companies do produce a range of pigments that include artists' grade colourants of very consistent and very high quality, but the pigment attributes and even its availability are specified by an industrial end use, not by the art materials market. For example quinacridone gold (PO49), a lovely, deep yellow pigment offered by several watercolour lines, is no longer manufactured. Why? Because automotive manufacturers stopped buying the colour. Watercolour manufacturers will continue to manufacture paints using remaining stockpiles of the pigment. Once a paint manufacturer has assembled the necessary raw ingredients, the methods of mixing paints have remained relatively constant for over a century. Today larger machines and manufacturing lines can produce greater quantities of paint. But the availability and quality of the ingredients is determined by their suppliers.

My 2 terms as membership convenor have been very satisfying and I have enjoyed the opportunity to be part of the BFAA executive.


