FAUSTA FACCIPONTE- BIO

Fausta is a visual artist and professor of photography in the Art and Art History Program at the University of Toronto Mississauga and Sheridan College. She received her BA from the University of Toronto and her MFA from Lesley University in Cambridge, Massachusetts. Fausta has shown her work both nationally and internationally and has received grants from The Canada Council of the Arts and Ontario Arts Council; and in 2018 Fausta was a finalist for the K.M. Hunter Award. In 2020, she received a grant from the Canada Arts Council to create a series of digital originals for online sharing in response to the pandemic.

She has been acknowledged for her work by the Globe and Mail, Carousel Magazine, Now Magazine, Eyes In, Flavorwire Magazine, and Create Magazine. Her photographs are in the collections at McMaster Museum of Art, Peel Art Gallery Museum + Archives, Art Gallery of Mississauga and Shelter Hotel in LA, California. Her work is part of a project and publication with the John Hopkins University of Medicine (Baltimore), and MAPS – a project co-organized by the McMaster Museum and the School of Nursing that teaches medical students visual literacy. Her photography is represented by the Stephen Bulger Gallery in Toronto.

Her new work, titled Little Tragedies and New Beginnings was recently on display at the Art Gallery of Burlington, Perry Gallery. The work engages with the fragile moments of life and the complexities of repair.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This online course is designed for the BFAA artist who seeks to advance their art practice by focusing on their professional skills. Over a 6-week period, artists will understand the importance of support material, learn how to document their artwork, explore exhibition opportunities, identify themes in their work, understand the grant application process and gain insight and confidence into exhibition layout and promoting their work. Artists will clarify their artistic goals, define their career vision and develop a working plan that is unique to everyone.

Materials needed: Participants should be prepared to write as the course will focus on writing exercises.
