WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION:

Photographing Your Art - Interactive On-line Workshop

If you need to photograph and document your artwork for your website, competitions or for reproduction you need to understand how it's done from the perspective of a pro photographer. This is a two hour entry level 'shooting artwork' workshop. We will look at how you can best photograph your artwork with limited resources. This will be an interactive Workshop with open mics so questions can be answered as they arise.

MATERIALS REQUIRED

FOR THE WORKSHOP:

- Digital camera, lenses, phone camera
- Tripod, if you have one
- Photography lighting, if you have it
- A piece of white foam core sheet/ board (\$ store) as a reflector if you are working in a bright room with only natural daylight and no direct sun. The room should be without direct sunlight.
- 2 equal intensity light sources, could even be lamps
- One piece of artwork to practice photographing
