"Structures Unveiled: A Diverse Canvas of Buildings" is an art exhibition that promises a multifaceted exploration of architectural marvels. Members can submit artwork that showcases a rich diversity of building types, spanning various styles and eras such as skyscrapers, historical landmarks, residential homes, cottages and unconventional structures.

Artwork Specifications:

- One artwork per member with Maximum size 360 sq in (H"x W") including frame.
- Gallery Canvas (minimum 0.7inches to a maximum 2 inches in thickness) or framed.
- Artwork must be original, two dimensional and submitted in the artist's choice of medium (e.g., painting, pastel, printmaking, mix media, encaustic, collage etc.).
- Artwork generated using an artificial intelligence (AI) platform is NOT permitted nor are the photographic reproductions or prints of original work. Work based on photographs taken by someone other than the artist can only be used if the artist can provide written permission from the original photographer. This includes any image(s) found on the internet, regardless of whether they are copyright free or in the public domain.

** We kindly request your cooperation in respecting the valuable time and efforts of our dedicated volunteers who are responsible for the intake, curation, and installation of the exhibition.


Conditions of Entry (Read Carefully, before entering online)


- 1. Open to all Burlington Fine Arts Association Members in good standing.

 BFAA Reserves the right to make the final decision on what is considered an acceptable entry.
- 2. There will be **no changes to the name or image of the artwork or its price** after the entry has been received. **Original artwork only**.
- 3. **Unframed canvas** should have sides finished.
- 4. **Digital files must be in JPG (jpeg) format**. Please ensure that the extension attached to the image file is .jpg. No other formats will be accepted. File size should be **no smaller than 500 kb and no larger than 2MB**. Image file name must be as follows: **last namefirstname_title.jpg example:**SmithMary_SpringMeadow.jpg.
- 5. Artists are responsible for remitting BFAA a commission of 20% up to \$500 of all sales at the Fireside Lounge and online exhibition.
- 6. **Work must be exhibition ready**, wired only, (no string, saw tooth or alligator clips) and properly screwed into back with appropriate D rings or screw hooks flat to back of painting. The wire should hang at 6" below top of large paintings and 3" below top for small or medium sized paintings. This ensures the piece will not scrape the wall and will be strong enough.
- 7. Artists may consider purchasing insurance coverage for their artwork.

- 8. **All inquiries for sales** in the Fireside Lounge will be first directed to Joan Carte, bfaaguild@gmail.com who will then notify the artist by email and telephone.
- 9. Works not picked up on the pickup date will be left at the artist's risk in the Fine Arts Studio. The Burlington Fine Arts Association or AGB is not responsible for the loss of or damage to the submitted artworks.
