The Guilds Spring Sale is an event with creations from all six guilds at the AGB. The BFAA is planning to be a big part of this exciting Guilds Sale but its success is dependent on having good participation by our members. Our focus for this sale will be to provide clients with small paintings ... "Small Jewels".

Please note re submission:

- 1. Initial submission to BFAA through EntryThingy
- 2. Brief Bio is required (50-80 words max); this will be featured with your paintings
- 3. Paintings will be grouped by artist where more than one painting is submitted
- 4. The Spring Sale focus is on small, affordable paintings
- 5. See Conditions of Entry below
- 6. A separate call will go out for the Unframed Room.
- 7. Consider volunteering for the Spring Sale to make it a success.

Submission Guidelines:

- Members may submit up to four (4) artworks online via EntryThingy
- Entrance fee for 1-4 pieces is \$15 total, payable by PayPal, debit or credit card
- All sales are subject to a 20% commission payable to Arts Burlington/BFAA
- Last Date of Submission online via EntryThingy April 26, 2024

Acceptable artwork Dimensions and selling price requirements:

- Apart from 6x6" paintings, art to be priced at a minimum of \$75.00
- Small paintings of 6"x 6" to be priced at \$50.00 and will be displayed either on tables or hung on the grids (space permitting)
- All paintings need to be properly wired as set out here
- Guidelines to consider for the paintings is the following: 6x6"; 8x8"; 10x10"; 12x12" or 14x14"
- Although we are encouraging our members to submit a square format, all small sizes will be considered; we ask you think about the impact of your section.
- Maximum size of painting is of 200 sq inches (inclusive of any frame).

Drop off: Thursday, May 23rd 4:00pm – 6:00pm

Pick up: Sunday, May 26th 5:00pm – 6:30pm

You will be asked to initial /sign an artist acknowledgement at the time of drop-off.

Volunteers make this event a success and your help is needed. A call for volunteers will go out in April if interested. It is a fun experience and is a great way to meet other members!


Conditions of Entry - Please read carefully prior to submitting online

- 1. This call is open to all Burlington Fine Arts Association members in good standing. BFAA reserves the right to make final decisions on acceptable art. **The work must be suitable for presentation in a public space, for all ages** (i.e., artwork may not contain profanity, religious or political subject matter, hate speech, graphic imagery, etc.).
- 2. There will be no changes to the name, image or price of the artwork after your entry has been received. Original artwork only. No giclee prints or other print reproductions of artwork.
- 3. Digital files must be in JPG (jpeg) format. Please ensure that the extension attached to the image file is .jpg. No other formats will be accepted. The maximum resolution should be no more than 1024 x 768 pixels at 72dpi, and be no larger than 2MB. The image file name must be in the following format: last namefirstname_title_size.jpg. Example: SmithMary SpringMeadow 6x6.jpg. Click here for some tips on how to resize your image.
- 4. **All work must be exhibition ready, wired only** (no string, saw tooth or alligator clips, or duct tape) and properly screwed into the back with appropriate D-rings or screw hooks flat to the back of the painting. Please see the diagram below for wiring instructions. Unframed canvas pieces will be accepted with finished sides only and must be wired as noted. **Art not properly finished, wired and labelled will not be accepted into the show.**
- 5. Art not picked up on the pickup date will be left at the artist's risk in the Fine Arts Studio. Neither the BFAA nor AGB is responsible for the loss of or damage to the submitted artworks. If you are not able to pick up your work yourself, please arrange to have a friend or family member do so, but kindly notify the Coordinators prior to the day of pickup.
- 6. There will be a separate request sent to all participants regarding submission of a brief biography of 50-80 words.
- 7. The artist acknowledges that the BFAA and its representatives will not be responsible for theft, or loss of, or damage to artwork; however, all reasonable care to safeguard the works will be taken while entries are in the Art Gallery of Burlington.
- 8. It is highly recommended that each individual artist obtains personal insurance for the Spring Sale to cover potential damage to the art caused by accident, act, omission or by intentional act of the AGB or a third party. The artist should ensure that the insurance covers the work(s) for the duration of the sale, exhibition, installation and take down.
